Teragren opens new plant in China

[Bainbridge Island, Wash.] Teragren has opened a new manufacturing facility in China to utilize the company's new XCORA Superior Strand Bamboo technology to create Synergy flooring and strand panel products. The offerings average 154 percent harder than red oak and 125 percent harder than North American maple.

"The application of this patented technology in bamboo is the wave of the future-it offers infinite possibilities in the building and construction industries-from interior to exterior building and structural products. Our re-engineering efforts have produced harder, more moisture resistant and stable strand products," said Teragren president and CEO, David Knight.

Located in Longyou, in the Zhejiang Province of China, the company's new 240,000 square foot strand bamboo manufacturing facility employs approximately 120 people.
