Hardwood Flooring

Armstrong's locking hardwood floors can be installed without glue, staples or nails over a variety of subfloors, much like click laminate flooring. The three collections—Hand-Sculpted, Global Species and Oak—offer 32 different designs in red and white oak, maple, kona, Australian wormy chestnut, ash, bamboo, birch, merbau and bangkirai.



Bamboo Butcher Block

Available in natural and caramelized colors, Teragren's bamboo parquet butcher block can be used for counters or tabletops. Made with a formaldehyde-free, food-safe adhesive, the butcher block is available in countertop sizes (30" x 96") and will soon come in a standard island size (36" x 72").



Textured Stone Counters

Like concrete, Shirestone Custom Countertops are stamped, stained and sealed to create a wide range of custom looks. Unlike concrete, this product is made of crushed stone and less than 1/2" thick, making it relatively light. It is poured on site and can be installed over an existing counter surface.



All-Natural Wall Tile

These coconut shell tiles from Maestro Mosaics feature elaborate woven patterns based on traditional Balinese art. The line includes 12-inch square and circular tiles, listellos and vessel sinks. The tiles have a ceramic backing and can be grouted like stone tile.
